Clarification on CS50 Class Rules

Notes on Measurement Condition and OD equipment

The ClubSwan 50 Class Authority confirms results of the informal "boat captain" meeting during Copa 2017. See below.

These are clarifications only do not modify the Class Rules, in case of conflict the Class Rules shall take precedence.

Following weighing and certification no changes shall be made to the items removed from the boat for the Measurement / Racing Condition without prior agreement of the Class Measurer and a revised Class Certificate if required.

The Following Items May be Removed for the Measurement / Racing Condition

- Optional Extras Listed in Appendix G (Class Rule Page 42)
- Cabin Doors (Excluding Toilet) – A MAXIMUM of 3 Doors may be removed
- Cushions & Mattresses
- Saloon Table
- Hanging Wardrobes
- Stove & Gas Bottle
- Second Service Battery
- Windlass Drum & Motor
- Spreader Lights
- 2 Fair Leads on Bow for Spinnaker Tack Lines
- 2 Inner Stoppers on Jib Tracks

The Following Items Are NOT Permitted to Be Removed

- All Interior & Wall Panels
- Fresh Water (Cold) Tanks & Water System
- Foredeck hatches are not permitted to be replaced with alternative materials
- Attachment points for hanging wardrobes
- Toilet door
- Gas struts on hatches & lockers (Foredeck gas struts permitted to be removed)
- VHF Cable

The following individually mounted equipment are legal:

One small cleat for trip lines at starboard pit,

Turning blocks leading traveller lines, keeping them at deck level

Two traveller cleats could be from any manufacturer,

Swivel cleat for jib lead may be repositioned to free up halyard organizer,

Lashings & small purchases with cleats are not limited and may be used as barber haulers
and when attached to existing structural points
